



Cross-border mobility in the Alpine Region

Co-financed by the European Parliament through the Alpine Region Preparatory Action Fund (ARPAF)

Proposal for a final event of AG4 and AG5 on the ARPAF Project Cross-border-mobility in the Alpine Region.

Content of the final event

The Cross-border mobility partnership, composed by AG4-Lead Office of the Tyrolean Government (Department of TransportPlanning), AG5-Co-Lead Swiss Centre for Mountain Regions and AG4 Observer CIPRA International, suggests to integrate into the EUSALP Annual Forum agenda of 29th of November 2019 a project closing event. The proposal contains the following elements a) a general presentation of main results, b) some experiences of representatives of test areas as well as c) a reflection and discussion of the before mentioned inputs in a moderated panel. The closing event would take place in the section of “Thematic workshop on priority topics of AGs projects” and would have a minimal length of 2 hours.

On this basis the participants will have the opportunity to learn about different findings of the strategic initiative of AG4 and AG 5 and discuss the main challenges in making the cross-border passenger/commuter mobility more sustainable. The event will also integrate the ICT enabling factors in term of infrastructures and digital services.

Foreseen elements:

- 1) Cross-border-mobility in the Alpine Region the main results

The main results of the different WPs will be presented as a succinct introduction of the closing event.

- 2) Going to the ground – experiences from the hotspot areas

Two representatives of hot spot areas (most probably Kufstein and Arc Jurassien) tell the audience about their main challenges in cross-border mobility and how the project contributed to their efforts in order to reduce cross-border road traffic flows and also mitigate its negative effects.

- 3) Discussion on key findings of the project “Cross-border-mobility in the Alpine Region”

In a moderated panel involving representatives of authorities, NGO’s and operators from different order regions the findings and recommendations of the crossborder-mobility will be discussed with a focus on implementation.

- 4) Next Steps

The consortium shortly presents how AG4 and AG5 further work with the project results (in particular the political recommendations).
